Tonight we will be hosting the parent teacher progress interviews for our Year 11-13 students. I am hoping that all parents and caregivers have given careful consideration to attending these meetings, as they are an important opportunity to gain clearer insight into your child's progress and next steps for learning. Our NCEA students have already crossed the mid-point in their year and we appreciate any additional support that can be leveraged from home to help keep the students on track. We are also hoping that parents and caregivers are engaging with the Attitude to Learning reports that are completed every fortnight and are available through our parent portal (parent.musac.school.nz). Students and parents can access this information and this helps track student progress more comprehensively over the year.

It was great to receive notification that an ex-student, Prof Sally Brooker was recognised in the Queen's Birthday Honours Awards and named as a Member of the New Zealand Order of Merit. Sally attended Hawarden Area School and was awarded school Dux in 1982. The honour is in recognition of her awardwinning research, which has taken place in collaboration with scientists in New Zealand, Australia, Europe, the United States, and Canada. The research has focused primarily on the structure, design, and synthesis of innovative new metal molecules whose spin states could be controlled and changed. Sally is also the author or co-author of more than 185 research articles in peer-reviewed publications and has delivered 51 lectures at international conferences, and received several international fellowships. It is wonderful to see a student from Hurunui College going on to be so successful on the national and international stage. She is certainly proof that Area Schools are great catalysts for success and we congratulate her on her latest award.

It has also been fabulous to see the momentum building towards our senior production, Rock of Ages, and the commitment that all involved are putting into

ensuring it is a successful event. Sarah Cassidy has taken on the producer's role and I'm sure she will be looking forward to the production starting in a fortnight's time. She is also closely supported by Phillip Biddlecombe and a number of other staff members who have taken on integral parts of the production. It is promising to be a fantastic event and I would encourage all to get in quick to purchase tickets when they come on sale, as I'm sure it will be a sell-out.

Also next Friday we have the main fundraiser for our Area Schools Sports Representatives at the Hawarden Rugby Club rooms. These students head away to Whangarei over the first week of the school holidays and will compete in Football, Rugby, Basketball, Volleyball and Golf. 
