CURRICULUM

Things are firing along in both classrooms with very much targeted learning programmes for students in literacy and numeracy. There has been some really fun STEM work with last Friday having Black Fire Snake experiment that the kids loved. The Senior Room older readers are now using ePlatform from Wheeler books to run their reading programme and allowing them to choose a range of stories across the curriculum as part of their reading programme. They have also been part of using Google Drive for their inquiry projects. The Junior Room is using Reading Box programme as well to help engage and encourage strong junior readers. Both of these reading programmes allow us to target comprehension and vocabulary from the reading our students undertake.
