SWEET AS!

The excitement is building! Classes are working hard to get their scenes ready for this year's extravaganza, Sweet As!

Thank you to the awesome parents who have already offered to help with the many tasks involved with a school production. It is not too late to offer your help! If you have skills with make-up, hair, sewing, crowd control then please make contact with your child's class teacher or Eileen Davids in H4.5.

Please note every child is involved in our school production and will be expected to perform each night of the 26th, 27th and 28th. We know they will be tired so are allowing them to arrive at school at 10am the morning after each performance. If this is not practical for your child then staff will be here at the normal time each day.

ENROLMENTS FOR 2018

Our school enrolment zone will be finalised by the Ministry of Education next week! Once finalised we will be asking for all in-zone families to please complete an intention to enrol form. This will allow us to work out how many out-of-zone places we will be able to offer for the 2018 school year. Once we have worked this out we will be advertising the number of out-of-zone places we have and asking for out-of-zone applications. All applications for an out-of-zone place at Bayview School must be received by Wednesday 18th October (please note this date is set by the Ministry of Education and we are unable to change this). If we receive more applications than we have spaces we will use the priorities as specified by the MoE to determine eligibility for spaces. For example, we may have 55 out-of-zone places we can allocate. If we receive 45 out-of-zone applications then all of those students will receive a place at Bayview School. If we receive 56 applications we will categorise each application in order of the priorities and allocate spaces according to the priorities. If there are 56 applications for priority 1 then we will have to hold a ballot.
