Junior Workshop



We had a fantastic turnout to the night, with 20 participants and 3 teachers attending.

Key Messages from the Evening workshop were:

1. If you have access to the internet at home & are comfortable with screen time - allow your child to use their Reading Eggs login to read books, take part in driving tests and lessons. The teachers can access their information to see how they are going at any stage.
2. The reading time at home should be an enjoyable time for everyone involved.

3. Learning to read is a slow, time-consuming, challenging, frustrating, rewarding and worthwhile journey. It is a different experience for each child and although the teachers work to a set of national standards and expectations - the children work to their own timeframes

4. Patience, humour and enjoyment are crucial to building reader's confidence!
