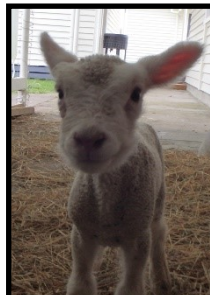
GPA LAMB PROJECT

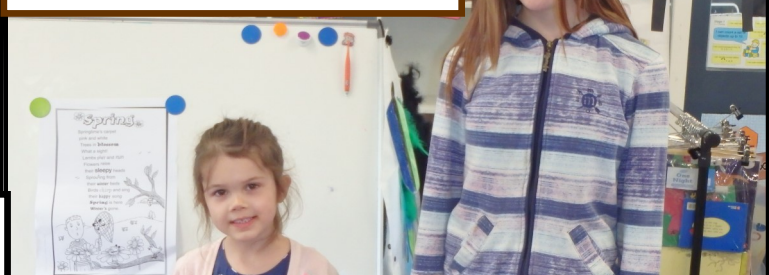

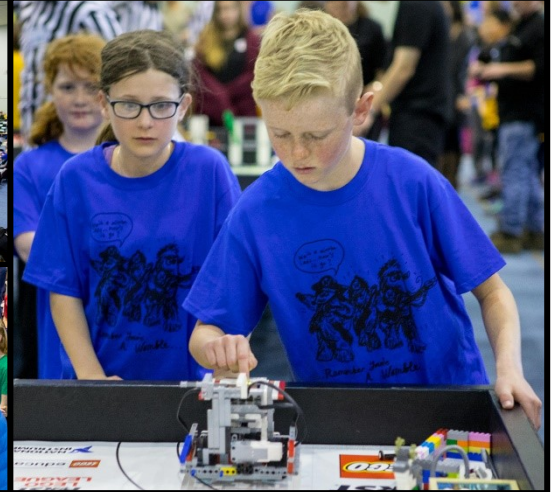
