## Principal's Comments:

#### Dear Families,

Welcome back to Term 4 and a special welcome to all our new students, especially those in Room 21 with Ms Todd.

It is always a busy time in Term 4 with many events happening as the school year closes. I would like to bring to your attention some **dates and times which you may need to know**:

- Next Wednesday 1 November at 6.15am we will have a blessing for the new buildings, led by one of kaumatua. Please meet in the Junior Quad at 6.05am if you wish to partake in this powerful ritual. The students will move into their new rooms on Monday 6 November. Please feel most welcome to attend.
- Next Thursday 2 November at 6.00am-9.00am we are hosting TVNZ Breakfast News and there will be trampolines for the children to jump on and challenge the presenters and Monty Beetham. If possible, send your children to school early-really early on Thursday.
- Junior Prizegiving (YO-Y3) is Thursday 7 December 1-3pm and the Senior Prizegiving (Y4-6) is Wednesday 13 December, 1-3pm. I respectfully ask that you do not bring preschool children to these formal assemblies as they are long, it is hot and the students have gone to a lot of work for their presentations.
- Middle & Senior Athletics sprints are to be held at Belmont Intermediate this year due to our grounds not being ready. This is Tuesday 7 November starting at 12.30pm. We will walk all children over to BIS. On Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 November, starting at 1.30pm the Middle and Senior Syndicates will do their field events at Belmont Primary.

Over the next three weeks we have students performing in our **Kapa Haka at BIS and Onepoto.** 

As you are aware, the school relies heavily on your school donation. If you have not paid this donation I encourage you to do so please. In a survey last year the parent community put more teacher aides as a priority for spending and the Board increased the number of teacher aides. We now pay in excess of \$140,000 a year in supporting many children with their learning. The government does not pay for teacher aides-the school does. The Board has also spent a lot of money on physical resources this year, including shade, which was the 2nd on the priority list. We have also spent a lot on playground equipment and resources for the rooms. The Board has upgraded toilet blocks and this week we are upgrading the swimming pool. We do need your financial support. School donations are tax deductible.

Regarding staffing, it is a pleasure that we welcome Louise Todd to our staff. Louise is teaching our New Entrant classroom till the end of the term. Louise has done a lot of relieving at all levels at our school and is also mum to Hettie and George Read. I am very grateful that Louise accepted my offer. On a sad note, today we farewelled Helena Gray, our lovely teacher aide for the past 4 years, mostly working in the Junior School. Helena is very creative, she is dedicated and a highly valued member of our staff. On behalf of the staff and students who have worked with Helena, we wish her well in her next adventures, whatever they may be. You will be missed.


