Kia ora Koutou Whanau, Well done to our school for getting behind "Dress up for Diabetes" Day. We were able to raise \$87.50 for our Rotorua Diabetes Association. Hopefully you were able to see our school in the Daily Post article on the fundraiser over the weekend. As most of you are probably aware, my daughter Harriet has Type 1 Diabetes which is an autoimmune disease. This is a chronic condition where the pancreas no longer produces insulin. Like many childhood diseases, it cannot be prevented or cured. 10% of the 260 000 New Zealanders that have diabetes have Type 1. The only way to manage this condition is to closely monitor blood glucose levels and inject insulin multiple times a day.

The most common form of diabetes is Type 2, which is usually detected in adulthood. Management options usually include making healthy lifestyle changes. Approximately 40 people per day are diagnosed. Type 2 diabetes is very prevalent in NZ and it is important to raise children's awareness as it usually can be prevented or delayed with a healthy lifestyle.

The money raised from days like 'Dress up' day will be used to put together support packs for newly diagnosed diabetics.

On another note, I have inserted a fact sheet about Scarlet Fever as there has been a diagnosed case of this in our school (including Strep Throat). So please have a look at the symptoms etc. and if you suspect your child may have this infection, the doctor can diagnose and prescribe appropriate antibiotics. We will talk to the students about the importance of washing their hands with soap and it would be great if you reinforce this regularly at home. :)






