On behalf of Auckland Transport, Fulton Hogan will be carrying out Pedestrian Crossing Improvements out at Coronation Road – Taylor Road Intersection, Mangere Bridge.

A new traffic control layout will be in operation during the work and brief delays may be experienced. Your cooperation in following the directions of any traffic control staff on duty and our temporary road signs would be appreciated.

On-street parking may be limited during work hours. Any vehicles parked in the work area will be towed to a safe position a short distance from the work site and may be returned to its original position by our approved towing company. Every effort will be made to locate the owner before towing. However, to avoid any inconvenience we would appreciate if you could park your vehicle away from the work area on scheduled work days. We will notify you directly if vehicle access to your driveway is likely to be affected. Should you require assistance at any time please do not hesitate to ask our onsite staff.
