Dear Parent/Caregivers

Rangikura and Papakowhai School Zones

Recently the Papakowhai School BOT provided feedback on the new proposed zone for Rangikura School. The Papakowhai School Board of Trustees expressed that it did not have any issues with the proposed zone as an interim step, while decisions are made regarding Schooling Provision in Northern Porirua. There is no immediate impact for our existing school community.

The Papakowhai BOT understands that the proposed move to incorporate the entire Aotea Block overlapping with Papakowhai School zone will provide a local school for Aotea residents not captured by Papakowhai Schools existing zone.

It is our expectation that both Rangikura and Papakowhai Schools will revisit zones once the larger decision is made about Schooling Provision in Northern Porirua. We understand that consultation on final options has moved out to early 2018.

We would also like to communicate that we will be undertaking a process to reduce our zone for the 2019 school year early in 2018. This is a process we have already signalled to our community.

We are in the early stages of seeking support from the Ministry of Education to enable informed decisions regarding our zone. Our initial request will be for data modelling of options for adjustments to our zone. We need to understand the impact of any revised zones which will enable informed engagement with our community.

We will engage you once our process is underway.
