Dear Bayview Families,

This is our final full newsletter for 2017. As I reflect back on the year I can honestly say it has been a year of many highs and some lows. I am incredibly proud of what our students have achieved this year in all aspects of school life.

This year we have been holding celebration assemblies for all the students who have made accelerated progress each term. These students could well be those who are below the standard or those who are at or above. *Achievement can be considered accelerated when a student makes more than one year's progress over a year on a trajectory that will indicate they are achieving at or above the standard at the end of year 6 or sooner.*

The students are driving their own learning at Bayview. Our school vision is:

We are independent, life-long learners!

We have very clearly seen this vision in action this year with students setting up bee hives at school, running muffi days, organising film events, we have even had students organise and go on trips out of school to visit playgrounds across Auckland. We have a group of students who are reporting back to the BOT at the December meeting around what they feel should be included in the new playground!

Students have a voice at Bayview School, because it is their school! This has been clearly demonstrated with the new murals adorning the walls of our school. The messages in the murals were developed by the students, and the graphics were chosen by the students using the token reward system.

This year we have also been fortunate in having a Schools Chaplain come and be based at our School. Tani is available on Tuesday's to speak with children or parents about worries or concerns. Tani is just a listening ear and may be able to support student to work through issues. Tani is based in the office at the end of the ESOL room if you are interested in meeting with her.

This year we have seen many building projects happen around the school. We have fixed our leaky roof, fixed broken drains, completed an electrical upgrade, replaced the window seals where they had shrunk and fallen out and added an extra staff toilet to cope with our roll growth. Over the summer break there will be further works happening at Bayview. Habitats 4 and 5 will be removed for demolition and a new court area laid in this space and next to the hall. We are also having 4 new relocatable classrooms placed on the top court. There will be lots of workman, big trucks, and this will pose a considerable risk to unsupervised children playing at the school. I can't tell you exactly when this is all going to happen just yet, but will let you know as soon as I know!

It is tradition at Bayview School for our Y6 students to leave behind a legacy when they head off to intermediate school. This year the Y6's are building a bike track which can be used at break times during school time and after school and weekends by the community. This is going to be a cool asset! Just another example of the Bayview community in action!

Our very final newsletter will be coming home with your children's reports on Friday 15th December along with other crucial notices.
