Senior Camp:

The 2 day senior camp will be held at the YMCA Raukawa Falls, on Thursday 8th and Friday 9th February (second week back) at a cost of \$45.00 per student.



It will give our Year 7 and 8 students a chance to mix and work with others of the same age from the 6 cluster schools.

One of the activities will be the High Ropes which will be part of the Tuia Challenge (senior students will undertake 4 different activities as part of this challenge during 2018).

Stationery:

Togs, Towels, Hats & Sunscreen:

A reminder for all children to bring their togs and towel everyday (and a plastic bag to put their wet things in). Children should also have a sunhat wide brimmed or bucket type are best, and should be applying



sunscreen throughout the day. The school has sunscreen available from the Cancer Society, or children can bring their own.

The swimming pool is looking great and the children are really enjoying being able to swim. REMEMBER—it is usually a good 5 degrees hotter at school than in town, due to the valley that we are situated in. Children also need to remember to stay hydrated during the day - drinking lots of water or milk.

WAITANGI DAY - 6th February:

Waitangi Day this year falls on a Tuesday, so children will have school on Monday the 5th then **NO SCHOOL** on **Tuesday the 6th February**.

We realise that some families may want to take the Monday off school to make for an extended long weekend—if you are going to do this please advise the school preferably on Friday, or at the latest by Monday afternoon, so we can let the van driver know.
