I am very proud to say that after our ERO review we have received the best feedback about what we are doing at Bayview School. We have worked hard to ensure children are at the centre of everything that we do and that they are driving their learning. ERO saw this and were very impressed with how well our students could articulate their learning. They were impressed with how we interweave our values throughout everything that we do and that our students 'live' the golden rule.

We will now await the report which is drafted, checked, submitted to us for review and then moderated nationally. We should get the final review by the end of July at which time we will be able to share it with you.

FEEDBACK TO PARENTS MEETINGS

On Thursday 30th June Bayview School will be **closing at 1pm** to hold our mid year feedback to parent meetings. These meetings are where teachers will tell you how your child is progressing towards the national standards.
