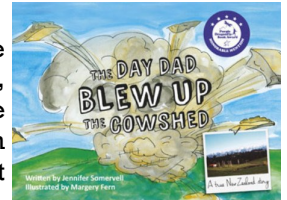

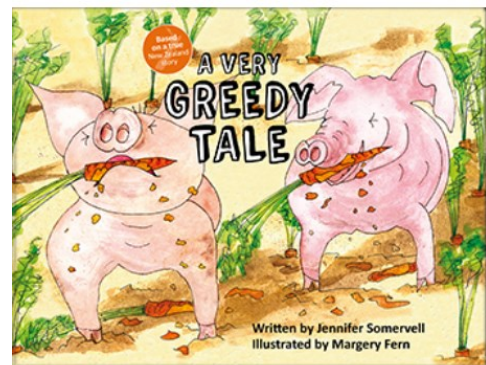

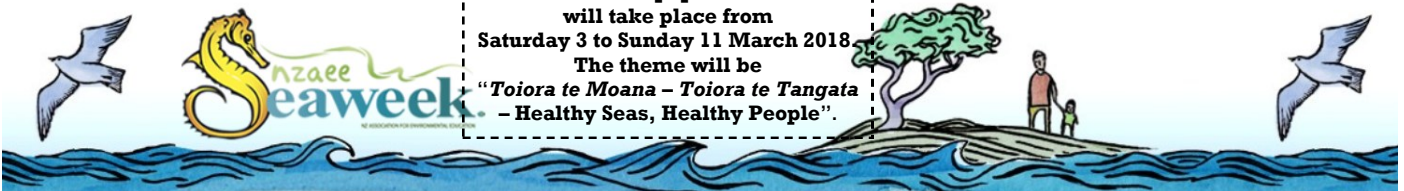
Jennifer will enlighten the students on how her stories are written and what inspired her to write them, and the process of a picture book production. Parents, family and whanau are welcome to come along and listen.

Last week our Year 7 & 8 students had the Health nurse visit and speak about the Boostrix immunization for Year 7 students, and the HPV vaccine for Year 8 students. These students had consent forms that they took home which need to be signed and returned to school ASAP, even if you do not wish your child to be vaccinated (you need to complete the part that says NO—section B).
