SOCIAL SKILL – RESPECT Our Social Skills focus for the next few weeks is Respect.



It's a word that our children hear frequently, although most children don't have a good understanding of how it affects them and others.

Children know that they want to be treated with tolerance and understanding, but many don't display the same courtesy to others.

How can children develop respect?

- Being able to have respect for individual differences in people.
- Being able to differentiate between being respectful and disrespectful.
- That to have self-respect is to behave in ways that make them feel good about themselves.
- Recognise that they are responsible for their own behaviour.
- Understand that respect starts with them.
- Understand that everyone wants respect and that when they give respect, that get it back in return.

Teaching respect to children can be broken down into 4 areas:

- Having respect for feelings.
- Having respect for differences.
- Having respect for rules.
- Having self-respect.

Remember... to get respect, you have to give respect. It starts with YOU!

This year we will be using Seesaw, instead of the portfolio folders. Seesaw gives your child creative tools to capture and reflect on their learning - in real time. Then this work is shared with you.

We need your help with Seesaw to ensure success. You can download Seesaw's family App for iOS, Android, or use the web to view your student's learning.

When your child adds new work, you will receive a notification to see, hear and respond to your child's post. You only have access to your own child's work and all of the content is stored securely.

REGIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH NOTIFICATION

We have been notified by Regional Public Health of an increase in cases of gastric upsets caused by the cryptosporidium bug (especially in children who had used the Raumati splash pad on Wellington Anniversary weekend). We would like to remind parents that people can still be infectious even though diarrhoea has stopped. This is why Regional Public Health recommends that children stay away from school for 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. It is important for children to keep out of swimming pools (or away from splash pads) for 2 weeks after the diarrhoea has stopped as the bug can spread easily in pools.
