*Completion of the course will coincide with the Reporoa Junior Rugby muster which will be on Tuesday 22nd March 2016 3.30pm - 6pm.* 


These sessions are free of charge, encourage good sportsmanship, participation and will be run by local parents/players of Reporoa Rugby Club.
