### **PTA News/Notices**



## Mufti Day for Tonga's recovery from Cyclone Gita

On **Friday 16th of March** Mangere Bridge School is going to be fundraising for **The New Zealand Red Cross Pacific disaster relief fund**. In Tonga, which felt the full strength of cyclone Gita, Red Cross is distributing relief supplies such as shelter kits, tarpaulins, kitchen sets, solar lamps and hygiene kits to help people temporarily repair damaged houses and survive without power and water.



We ask that students please wear mufti (red and white if you can) on Friday 16th March and bring along a donation (a gold coin - or more if possible). The plan is that we give what we can.

Two MBS students, Jackson and Connor, feel strongly that the students and families of Mangere Bridge School join together to contribute to Tonga's recovery from cyclone Gita, and we agree with them! The boys have bought a big box of ice blocks for the class who donates the most money!
