Parenting is probably one of the hardest jobs around, but few people have any training for it. If you're

interested in learning more about being a better parent, The Incredible Years programme could be for you.

The Incredible Years programme is for parents with children aged 3 to 8.

It will help you learn ways to:

- •build a healthy relationship with your child
- understand your child's development
- •encourage positive behaviour
- •address challenging behaviour.

This course is one 2-3 hour session a week, for eight weeks. We have the opportunity to run this at our school if we have 15 or more parents



interested in attending. It is a great program that has been running for years and is of benefit to ALL parents who have taken part.
