FUNDRAISING AT BAYVIEW

At Bayview School we run two types of fundraising. The first is overseen by our Friends of Bayview School fundraising group. These fundraisers include our annual raffle, mufti days, school productions, quiz nights etc. The other type of fundraising is driven by the students. To gain a silver or gold I CARE award the older students are encouraged to look beyond themselves and to do things that make our community and world a better place. Our group that organised the Heart Kids fundraiser are an example of this. Any fundraisers of this type must have a plan and must be presented to Shelley Matuku or myself to get permission to run it. At Bayview any fundraisers must benefit children, so when we raise funds for Daffodil day we send it to assist with Child cancer research. Shelley and I try very hard to schedule these events so that they do not clash. The expectation with these child driven fundraisers is that the children do the planning and organisation and not our parents. This is not saying that the kids might not need our help but it is much more valuable for the kids if we guide from the side as they learn a lot more.

FEEDBACK MEETINGS

We only have three weeks left of this term, can you believe it! Within the next few weeks our teachers will be making contact with you to arrange learning feedback meetings. Some of these will be child led and others will involve the teacher and your child sharing progress and achievement information. SPORTS UNIFORM

Last week we sent home a special letter explaining that we are moving to a new system for sports uniforms. This is for the uniforms that our extra curricula teams use when they play a sport for the school, i.e. hockey, basketball, netball, etc.

We will no longer supply uniforms for these teams, instead parents will need to purchase the uniform specifically for their child. This uniform will be used for each of the sports so if your child plays 4 different sports they only need the one uniform and it belongs to them!

The only exception to this is that basketball requires a singlet.

T-shirts, singlets and shorts are available for sizing in the school office. Orders must be made by 12th April so the uniforms can be ordered and have Bayview screen printed on the back.

Orders can be made on ezlunch or at the school office.

ANXIOUS CHILDREN

Over the last few years we have noticed an increase in the number of students exhibiting anxiety starting school. Most parents are great at working with the school to follow a plan to help with these anxieties especially the children anxious about mum leaving at school drop off. These plans are designed in consultation with a psychologists. Sometimes it can take a bit of time to work through these anxieties but a team effort normally sees success. Recently we have offered a meeting with a group of psychologists who run the 'Cool Kids' programme which is specially designed to assist these children. We had a few parents attend this meeting and were very impressed with this and they and their children will be working within this programme to help their kids. 
