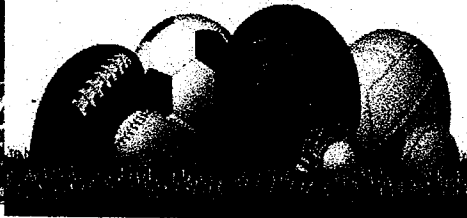


EASTER MONDAY AT PALLISER RIDGE:
