### ZERO WASTE PROGRAMME:



Next week we have Hadi Gurton, our Zero Waste Education educator at school on Wednesday the 4th and Thursday the 5th April where we will be looking at -

#### \* Reducing the Waste Pile (Juniors)

Reducing the waste pile' is the focus of this unit. Sensible shopping, recycling, composting and reusing are introduced as ways of making our waste pile smaller. Students are also introduced to the concept of waste, landfills and the five main natural resources that are used to make all the 'stuff' they consume.

#### \* Resource Sustainability (Seniors)

Natural resources - renewable and nonrenewable - are the focus of this unit. Students investigate how the production systems we currently use are affecting our ability to conserve our natural resources for future generations. Alternatives to these linear forms of production are offered as well as insights into



more sustainable business practices such as replacing waste streams with clean streams.
