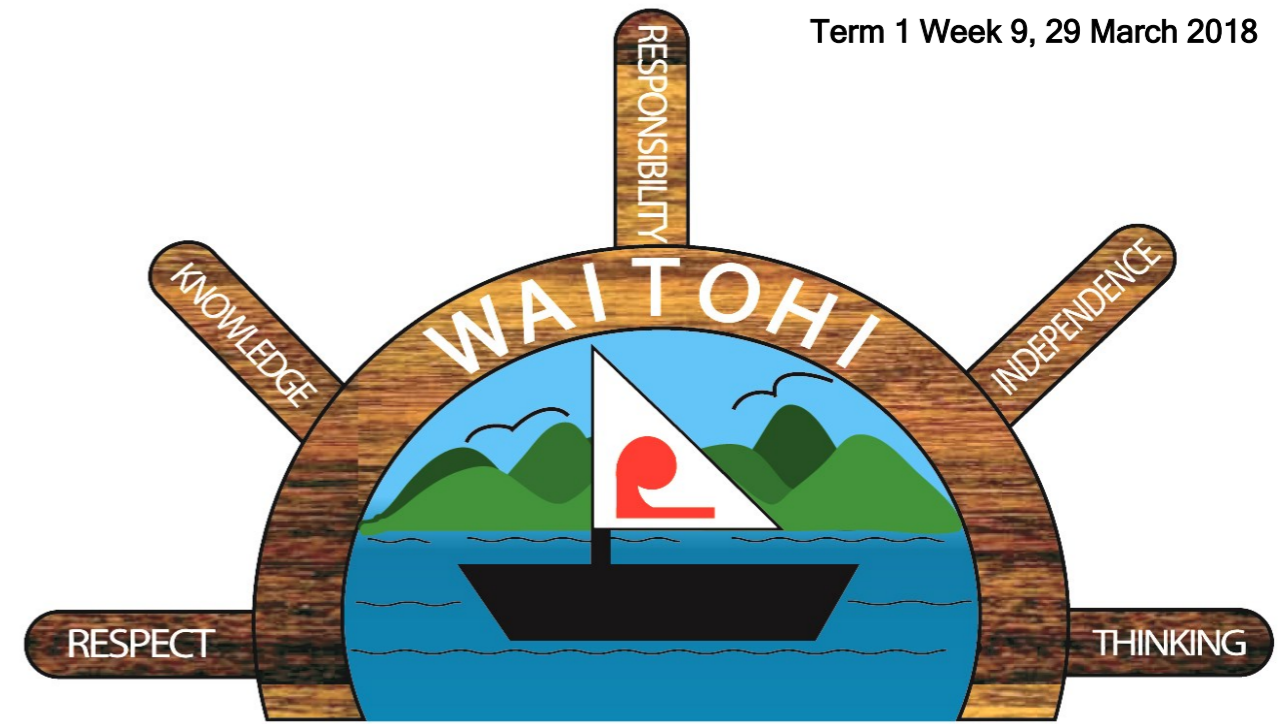

Daylight saving ends on Sunday April and it's time to get your winter coat, electric blanket and heater out of the cupboard.



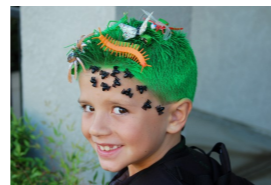
- Clean chimneys and flues before your first fire of the season.

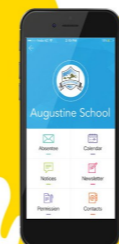

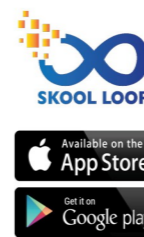

### Asthma

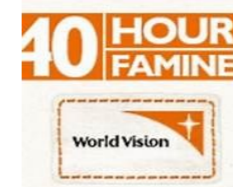
On Monday 9th April there will be an asthma awareness musical called 'Sailor Asthma Show' for the whole school.
