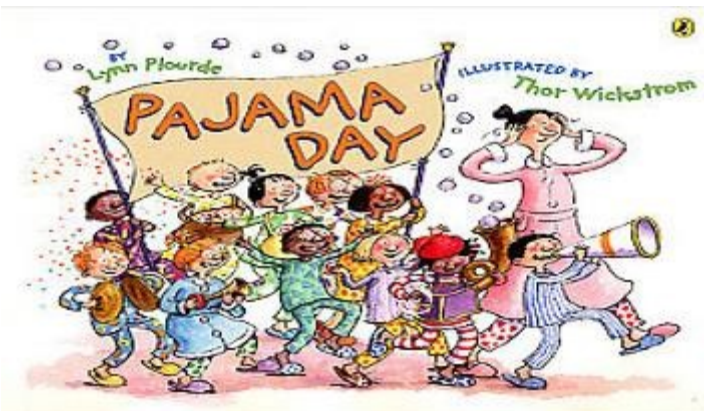


## CROSS COUNTRY
