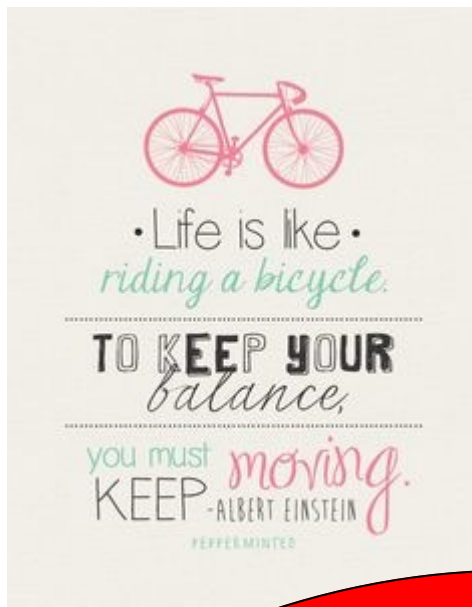
**MIDDLE YEARS PARENTING WORKSHOP**—continues **tomorrow night (Tuesday 21st), 6-8pm in the school staffroom.**

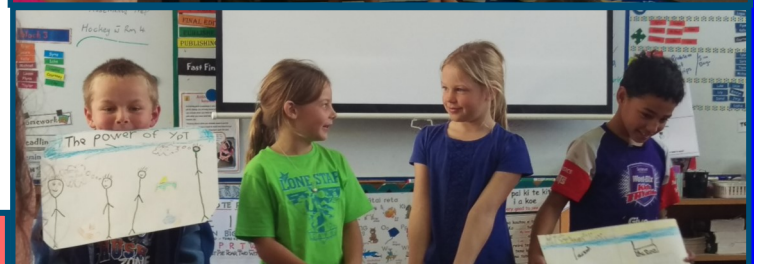
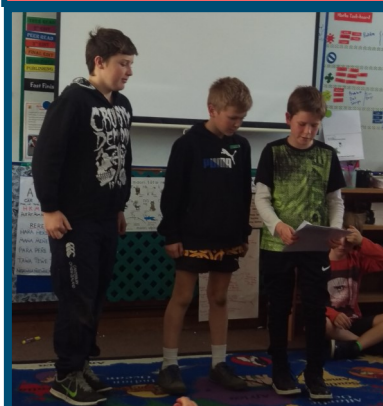
## SCHOOL LEADERS

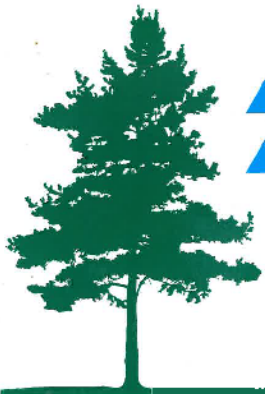
