To end the term in weeks 9 and 10, our Year 1-6 students will do their swimming block! What a busy term it is going to be.



12:30am	Return to kura (school)

Please note that times are only approximate and provide a guideline for the day. Room 1-3 will visit on Tuesday 8th and Room 4-5 on Wednesday 9th May.

If you have any questions about the day, please feel free to contact your child's teacher. We have spaces for 4 parent helpers to join us on Tuesday with Room 1-3 and 5 parent helpers on Wednesday with Room 4-5. This is a first in, first served basis. If we have extra adults, there will be a small charge of \$10 per adult on top of these numbers. The trip costs \$10 per person (student and adult) but is covered under the activity fee for our students.

Students will travel to the marae by school bus.
