GREAT GROCERY RAFFLE

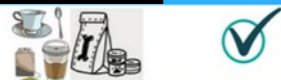
PSAS is doing a grocery raffle so we can continue to subsidise events, buy play equipment and much more for the children of Picton School.

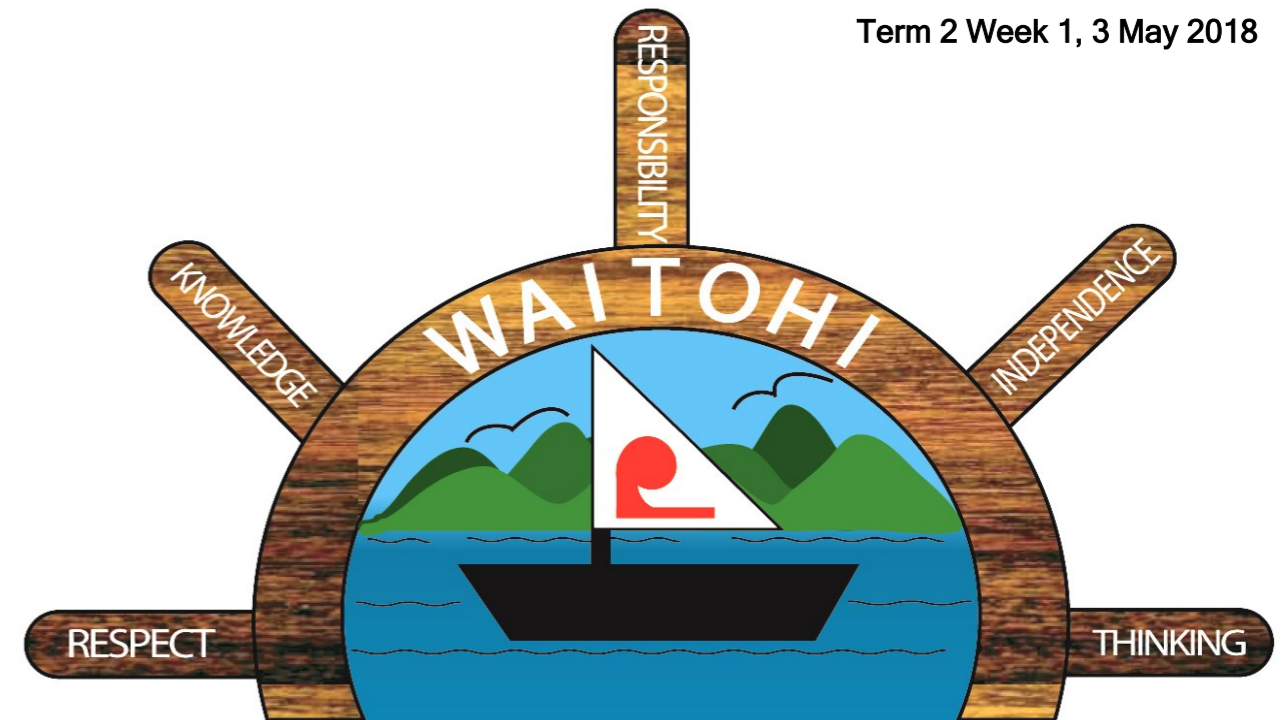

Drains are for Rain

Hints for cleaner Picton waterways

Wash your car on the lawn so that the soapy water soaks into the grass, instead of running into the gutter or use a carwash where the water can be recycled.
 Clean your paint brushes at an inside sink (which is connected to the sewer), not the drain by the outside tap.
 Recycle your used engine oil - at your service station.
 Never tip garden sprays or fertilizers into the drains.
 Put the backwash water from your swimming pool into the sewer.
 Sweep - don't hose your driveway and footpath.

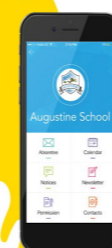
Native Plant Sale

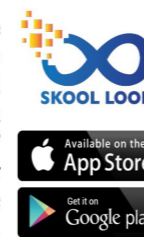
