What do you like to do in your spare time?

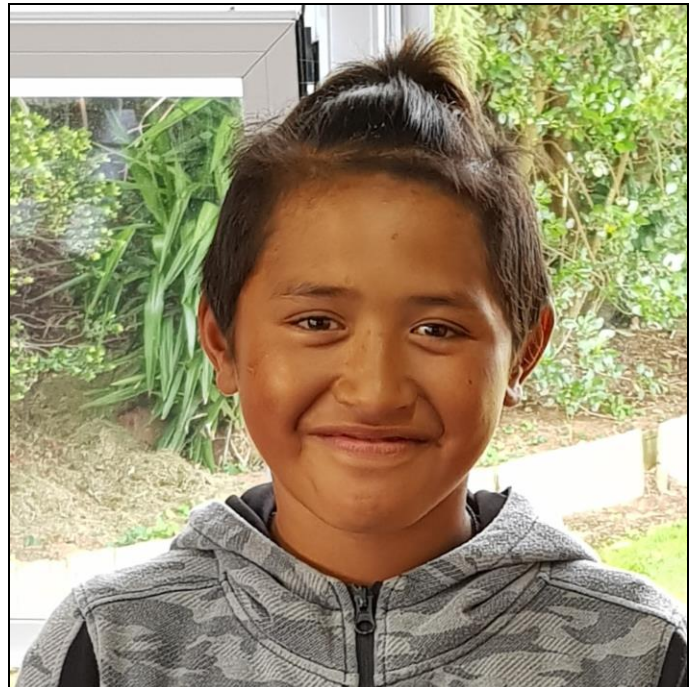
Ride around Waitara on my bike and do wheelies.
