

# Whanau Conference online Survey completed by 92 families Thanks for sharing your thoughts with us. Here is a summary of what you told us..

We had 259 out of 265 which is 98% families attended 84.1% Used the booking online system and found it an easy system to use.

64% believe 15 mins is just the right amount of time for a discussion 33% would like a longer time with 20mins being the most common suggestion-parents stated they would like the opportunity to talk about the whole child rather than just reading, writing and maths.

57% said the early finish was no problem for them to arrange childcare.

43% said it was ok

9% found it difficult or extremely difficult

#### Reading

87.2 % Have a clear understanding of their child's reading level

86.7 % Have a clear understanding of their child's next steps

92.2 % Have a clear understanding of how they can help at home

97.7 % Set collaborative targets and 99% felt they were right

#### Writing

87.2 % Have a clear understanding of their child's writing level

80.9 % Have a clear understanding of their child's next steps

77.8 % Have a clear understanding of how they can help at home

95.5% Set collaborative targets and 99% felt they were right

#### Mathematics

83.0 % Have a clear understanding of their child's maths level

86.7 % Have a clear understanding of their child's next steps

85.2 % Have a clear understanding of how they can help at home

96.6 % Set collaborative targets and 97% felt they were right

94% of attendees received support materials

43% rated the materials as Excellent 42% rated the materials as Very Good

Overall Rating of Whanau Conference Experience Excellent 60% Very Good 31 % Good 9 %

#### Commonly suggested improvements

- -More time to talk about the whole child e.g social and behavioural needs
- -Include a general comment re behaviour, social skills and other learning areas science, social studies, arts, physical education
- -The survey did not allow people to select more than one ethnicity
- -Getting the Conference sheet ahead of time to read would be good

#### **Positives**

- -Really liked new format it was easy to understand and made it very clear where their child was achieving and where they needed to be by the end of the year.
- -Like the new approach, clear and well understood
- -Timing of the year just right because we have targets and now know what to do
- -Well explained by teachers and we have a clear understanding of child's needs
- Like setting goals together
