HAND, FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE

We have had a case of hand, foot and mouth disease confirmed in Rimu block. Symptoms include a mild fever followed by blisters in the mouth and on the palms of the hands and soles of the feet. Children may also feel tired, lose their appetite or complain of a sore throat/mouth. Affected children should be kept home from school until the blisters dry up. 
