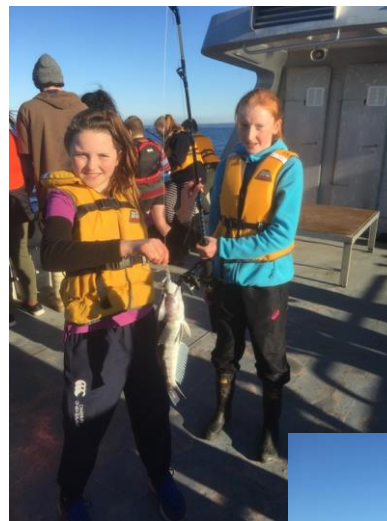


Tokanui Senior Rugby Club
