Thank you to Four Winds Foundation for their generous grant towards the Bike track. We really appreciate your support. Construction will start in November.




Thank you to Mangere-Otahuhu Local Board for their generous community grant towards the container for the storage of the bikes and helmets.

On the next page, pick your child/children's teacher you want to meet and then press "Go"



Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teacher is available. Simply click on the times that suit you and then press "Go"

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. And you can return to the site and enter the event code **73gga** again to change or cancel your interviews.
