#### **ENROLMENT ZONE**

This is a summary of a BOT newsletter shared over the school holidays. The full newsletter and supporting documents can be found on our website www.papakowhai.school.nz.

The zone that was proposed during the formal consultation will be adopted from 1 January 2019, with one minor clarification. Peel Lane was shown in-zone on the draft map but was not named in the list of in-zone streets. Peel Lane has been added to the list of in zone streets.

There have been no other changes to the zone proposed during the formal consultation.

The Board agrees with submissions that said it is difficult for parents to make fully informed choices about their children's schooling (and how Papakowhai School sits in their future plans) until the Ministry provides clarity about a proposed new school in Aotea.

As an interim step while we await clarification about a proposed school at Aotea, Papakowhai School will advertise up to ten out of zone places for 2019 for year one siblings of current pupils.

Children starting school up to the end of Term 4 2018 are not affected by any future changes in zone.

# **ENROLMENTS FOR 2019**

To assist with planning for 2019 we need to check we have an accurate list of enrolments for next year.

If you fall into one of following categories, please contact the Office by August 31:

- i) You live in zone and have a new entrant child who turns 5 in 2019 and you have not already given pre-enrolment details to the Office.
- ii) You live in zone and currently have a child attending a different school that you intend to enrol at Papakowhai in 2019.

If you have a friend or family member that does not have a child currently attending Papakowhai School and you think that they may fall into one of the above categories, please get them to contact the Office also. If you are unclear about the boundaries of the school zone, please refer to our website.

If you fall into one of following categories, please contact Acting Principal Caine Webster, before August 31, by email to <a href="mailto:caine@papakowhai.school.nz">caine@papakowhai.school.nz</a>

- i) You currently live out of zone (or will be out of zone from the January 1 2019 changes) but have children already attending Papakowhai School, have a new entrant child who turns 5 in 2019 and you have not already completed an enrolment form for 2019.
- ii) You have a child currently attending Papakowhai School and you are planning to enrol them at a different school in 2019.

# **Out of Zone Places for 2019**

There will be up to 10 out of zone places for 2019 for Year 1 siblings of current pupils. There will be no places for children who do not have a current sibling at school. The process for this is as follows:

• Pre-enrolment of out of zone Year 1 children who have a sibling currently attending Papakowhai School will need to be received by August 31 2018.


- •The BOT will determine from the pre-enrolments how many places are likely to be available in 2019 for out of zone Year 1 siblings of current students.
- •On September 11, by notice in a newspaper, the BOT will advertise the number of out of zone places that the Board has determined and seek applications by September 21, 2018.
- •A ballot, if required, will take place on Wednesday 26 September.

At the start of November, a notice will be sent home advising parents / caregivers who will be teaching which class in the school. Parents/caregivers will then be able to contact the principal with class placement requests.


If you pay your donations by termly instalments could we please remind you that the payment for Term 3 is now due.

# **KEEPING OURSELVES SAFE**

During weeks 5, 6 and 7 of this term students will be participating in the Keeping Ourselves Safe Programme. Keeping Ourselves Safe [KOS] consists of a comprehensive range of child protection resources to help students learn and apply a range of safety skills that they can use when interacting with others. The programme is delivered by classroom teachers with in class support from our Community Police Constable - Susan Bush. For more information, you can access all the KOS resources here, or see the frequently asked questions. A parent/caregivers and whanau information meeting will be held at school on Wednesday 8th August at 6.00pm. This meeting will be facilitated by our Community Police Constable - Susan Bush.

What will students learn during the Keeping Ourselves Safe programme?

They will learn:

- To work out when their safety is at risk, for example walking home alone in the dark;
- How to keep safe when they meet and mix with other people;
- Who and how to ask for help if they, or someone they know, is being abused;
- To go on asking for help until someone does something to stop the abuse;
- That it is important to make and follow personal, family and school safety rules.

They will know that abuse is never okay and that abuse is never their fault.
