WELCOME BACK TO EVERYONE FOR TERM 3

I hope you all had a restful break. We are all looking forward to another busy term and – hopefully – an improvement in the weather with warmer, drier days. We would like to welcome back Foroogh Mossadegh to Room 23 and our new teacher, Tash Cooper, to Room 9.

Disappointing Start to Term 3: I am sorry to have to start with a negative, but on Monday 2 of our new portable outdoor speakers were stolen just after morning tea. <u>Pre-enrolments</u>: If you have a child who is about to turn 5, would you please make sure that you come along to the school to begin the enrolment process. Would you please make sure that you name all of your children's uniforms and other items so that we can return lost property to the correct owner. There is now a labelled black box in the office foyer for lost property if you wish to check it.

Breakfast Club: This runs every day, from 8.00 – 8.30 am in Room 11, and is free to all students.

<u>Skateboarding</u>: The after-school skateboarding lessons will be running again this term, from next Monday 30 July. Cost is \$5 per session and skateboards are supplied.
