What a wonderful day the two senior classes had at Fortrose on Tuesday. The weather held for us and was perfect for exploring what lives in the mud in the Estuary. It was great to have the expertise of Scientists from Otago University and the Environment Southland team. Thank you to all of the parent helpers who made it possible to have the children down by the water. My favourite part was the experience of the touch tanks that are transported in the Aguavan. We got to see up close and touch a variety of star fish, kina, a variety of crabs and sea cucumber. We have been lucky enough to get this opportunity because we are a part of Enviro Schools and because of our proximity to the Mataura River. Some of our students just may want to be scientists when they are older.

We are hoping for fine weather on Friday for the Moffett Cup. Netball will be on no matter what happens with the weather. If rugby is off there will be school as normal for those children. In 1948, Mrs Moffett donated a cup for the standard 3 and 4 (Year 5 & 6) rugby competition in the Southern Southland area. This is where the Moffett Cup competition originated from and this is why is is unique to our zone.

Teachers have voted to take industrial action on the 15th of August. This isn't something that teachers take lightly; it is 24 years since educators have gone on strike. The fact that we are taking such a step now shows the grave concerns we have for the future of quality public education. It is alarming that we are unable to attract people into the profession and retain those that we have. It is also about providing for all children in an inclusive environment. Teachers and Principals want change so our students can have a teacher in every room and the learning support that the children need and teachers be recognised as the professionals that they are. Teachers and Principals feel that the Ministry's June offer did not address workload issues, extra learning support or ways to stem the growing crisis in recruiting and retaining teachers.

Prefer to have a block booking for the entire period, but as Rangers will be swapping over every two weeks, there can be some flexibility between available units.


Accommodation providers will not have to provide food, laundering or cleaning services during this time.
