Tēnā rā koutou ki ngā hau e whā, greetings to everybody,

A warm welcome back to all our Whānau and our new Whānau who have joined us this year. We have had over 16 new enrolments this year.

The start of 2016 has seen the end of the private bus run which was provided by Tranzit. Waitara East School has sought funding from various places to help in the funding of a **Mini-van** to transport our children to school. Currently staff are picking children up and bringing them to school who have no transport so a big thank you to them. Next Tuesday we will begin the Mini-van run. Letters have gone home today to those parents who have returned the permission slip for the run. There is a cost which will need to be paid by the end of next week. There is a maximum number that we can take and that is 33 passengers. If you missed the letter sent home on Wednesday please ring the office for more information.

Next Wednesday (10th February) we have our annual BBQ at the beach (Waitara West / Marine Park). This is where the school supply a free BBQ- sausage sizzle, meat pattie, bread, sauce, and water. We do not supply cups so whānau need to bring drink bottles. We have also invited Waitara Central School, Police Education Officers, and other Agencies that work within the schools to come along and meet and greet.

This week we have had Anna and Tony the police education officers training our Year 6 children to be road patrollers. Those children have until Friday to confirm if they want to be road patrollers for 2016. Each term Anna and Tony will be doing something special with the group to reward them for all their hard work.

Lynton our Caretaker has been working extremely hard cleaning and filling the pool and now checking the quality of the water. Each class will swim 3-5 times each week so can all children brings togs, towel, and a plastic bag please. This is an expectation, that all children will participate in swimming instructions. If children regularly do not participate in daily swimming lesson they may not partake in swimming sports on Thursday 10th March at the Waitara East Pools. If your child is unable to swim because of an illness please write a note to the classroom teacher. Thank you.

With all the sun of recent we are also encouraging all children to wear sun hats. From Tuesday 9th February all children will need a sun hat that shades the face.
