It is hard to believe that August is already upon us, although it certainly feels a lot more like October with the incredible unseasonal warm spell we are experiencing at the moment. It is quite scary and makes you wonder what is around the corner.

Last night we had both the Investigating Community (Year 8-10) Parent Teacher interviews and the Exploring Community Student Led Conferences. It was great to get an excellent turnout of parents and students and I trust that the feedback that was received is valuable and of use as we head into the second half of the year. It is important to ensure these opportunities are taken advantage of, as the information gained is a lot more than can ever be contained in a written report. Being able to see the student's work, as well as discussing the learning that is happening is more than we can ever feedback to you in a few pages. It is also important to remember that for students in Years 9-13, we no longer complete formal written reports. Student progress and attitude is fed back on a fortnightly basis via the Attitude to Learning Reports. We know a high number of students are reviewing these reports, but we are concerned that a number of parents are yet to engage with them. If you are yet to do so the easiest process is to type parent.musac.school.nz into your browser and then using the email address that you have given to us at school and then request to reset your password. Alternatively, come into the school office with 5mins to spare and we can get it all working for you. Once this is completed you will have access to school reports, daily notices, attendance information, student timetables and school payment information. The great thing about the parent portal is that it also allows access for more than one caregiver and parents living apart can both access the student information.

Just a note for parents and caregivers around change of address and access to bus transport. Hurunui College has two designated TEZ (transport entitlement zones). One for students in Years 1-8 and another for students in Years 9-13. When students live within these zones, the Ministry of Education undertakes assistance in getting students to and from school. If you live outside of these zones then there is no guarantee that transport will be available in the future. There are a lot of factors around this, but the simplest pretence is that entitlement is only

available to your closest school. This means that our Year 9-13 zone is a lot bigger than our Year 1-8 zone. If you are changing your address please ensure you let the school know and check if bus transport is still available. The Ministry of Education is currently reviewing bus routes across the country and those students receiving bus transport, but who live outside of the TEZ's are not considered in this review and it may impact on the long-term availability of transport options. Please get in touch with the school if you have any questions or concerns.

It has been great to be part of the Hurunui Has Got Talent auditions this week. It is fantastic to see individuals and groups of students being brave enough to put themselves forward for this event. Sadly not all items will be able to be included as part of the show, but this should not take anything away from the effort that has been put in and the talent on show by all who have auditioned. Final auditions are on Friday. The Hurunui Has Got Talent finals will be in the school hall/gym on Thursday the 6th September starting at 6.30pm.

Chicken Pox Vaccine Free for children turning 15months of age and children turning 11 years of age, who have never been infected with or previously immunized against chicken pox. The vaccine is also obtainable for children, teenagers and adults but a charge will be incurred.

Flu vaccine Free for people 65 years and over AND for children living in the Hurunui aged 6 months – 17 years old. Also for people with certain chronic conditions. Please ring for an appointment.

Zostavax Free for 65-80 year olds.

Measles This is circulating in the Canterbury region. If you or children in your care are unimmunized please talk to the Practice Nurse for advice. There is a catch up programme in place for adults who are unsure of their immunization status.

Smoking Cessation Advice is available at the Health Centre if you need help to quit smoking.

Appetite for Life Would you be interested in attending a course once a week for six weeks, locally, that shows you how to prepare nutritional meal and snack ideas for the family and how to make healthy choices around food and lifestyle? This is open to both men and women of any age. Please ring and talk to the practice nurse if you are interested in this.
