How to customize a sprite for a speed drawing project.

- First search for and open this website and click on create: https://scratch.mit.edu/
- Start with a new sprite by clicking the paintbrush icon beside 'New Sprite:'.
- Click on your blank sprite and open the costume tab.
- Select the customisation tools as needed and start drawing the first few shapes
 of your
 creation.
- Draw a few details and shapes in each costume
- To create a new costume click the paintbrush icon under 'New Costume:'
- Colour in your sprite if you want to or need to

How to code the script for your speed draw project.

To book your Whanau Conference, go to **www.schoolinterviews.co.nz/code** in your browser, and enter the event code **73gga**. Then follow these three simple steps:



First enter your name, your student's name, and your email address.

If you need to book for more than one student, change the "Book for 1 students" setting, and enter the other student's name.



On the next page, pick your child/children's teacher you want to meet and then press "Go"



Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teacher is available. Simply click on the times that suit you and then press "Go"

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. And you can return to the site and enter the event code **73gga** again to change or cancel your interviews.
