Strike Action

Teachers and Principals have voted to strike on Wednesday 15th of August.

The Board of Trustees has made the decision to close the school because the teachers are not available to teach or supervise children.

To ensure student safety the school will be 'closed' for the day and there will be no staff at school, meaning the office is also closed.

The reasons behind the strike action are much bigger than is usually reported in the media.

The concerns across New Zealand are around:

- The lack of in-depth, continuous support for our children that have moderate to severe learning, behavioural and/or developmental needs. More specialist teachers and support workers are urgently needed.
- 2. The huge shortage of teachers (tired of hearing about Auckland a massive problem in Dannevirke!)
- 3. The retention of teachers a large percent of new teachers resign within 3 years of starting teaching.
- 4. Improving pay rates of teachers, so teachers stay in the job longer than 3 years and the pay is attractive to new teachers.
