Room 1 News

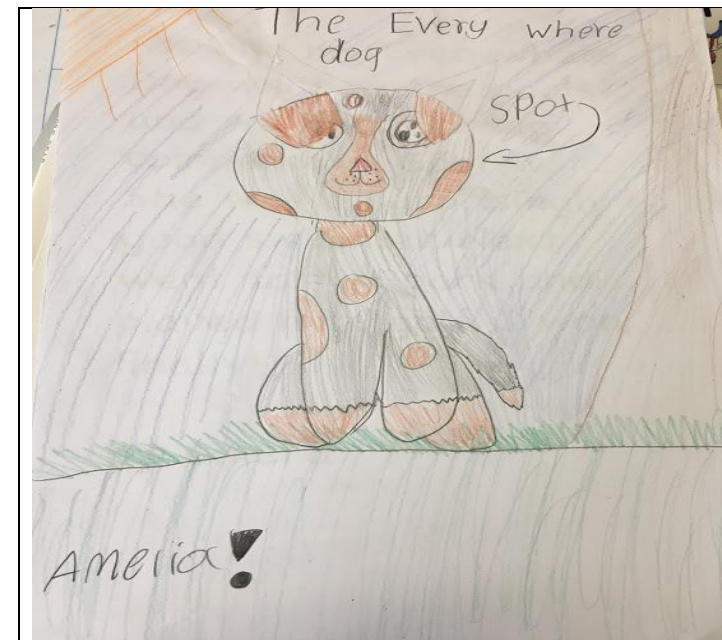
My best part of the story was when the mice turned into horses.
