Gumboots and Umbrellas Walk to School Day



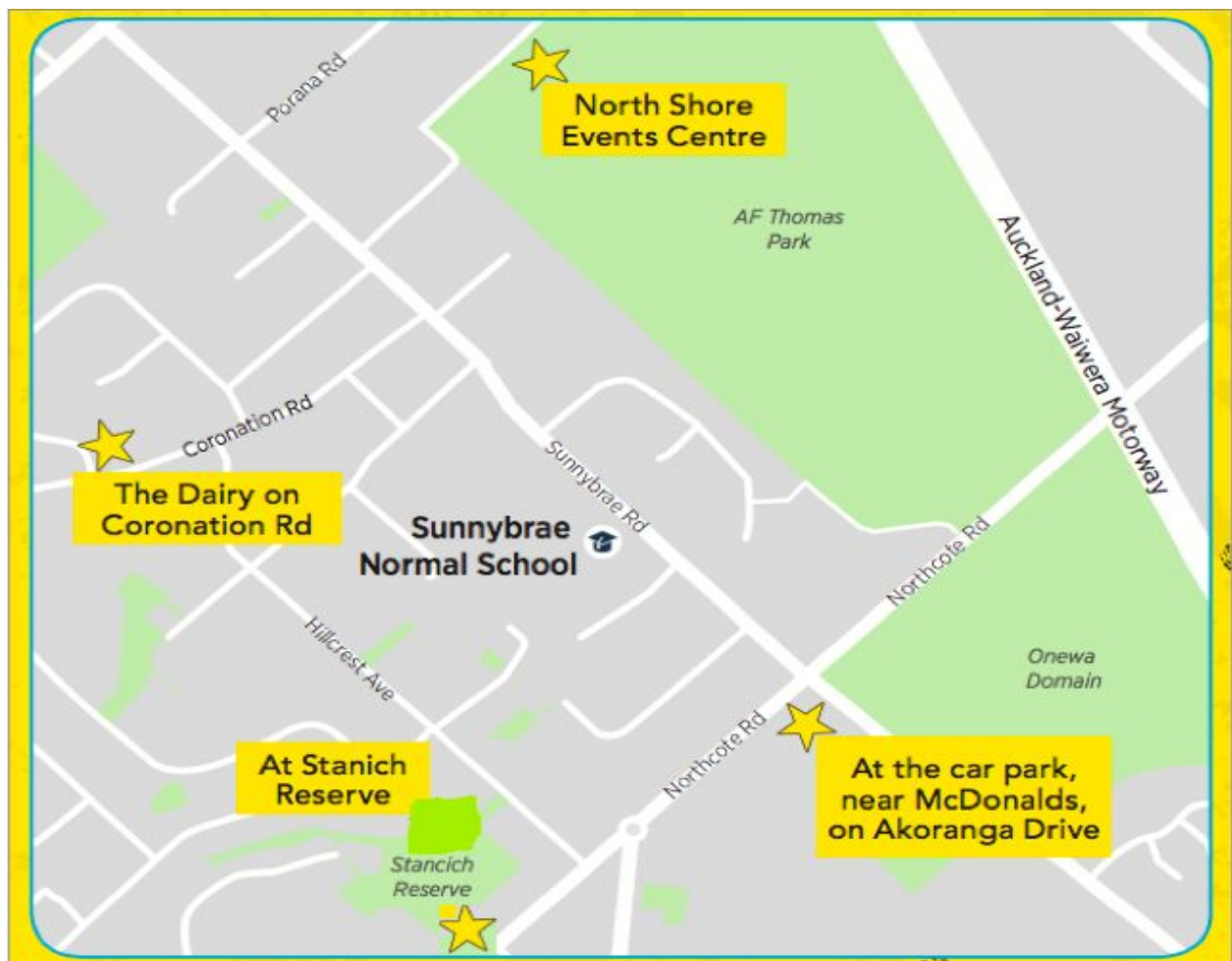
Meet the Teachers and Walk to School
