Swimming

Swimming starts on Monday for all the children in Rooms 10, 11, 12 and some of the year 4 children in rooms 5, 6 and 7.

Swimming days are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday next week and the following week.

Please ensure your child has their togs and towel and a bag for their clothes every swimming day.

Please also ensure their uniform is well named (not on the tag!) so it doesn't go missing in the changing rooms.

The year 4 children in rooms 5, 6 and 7 that don't swim this time will swim with their class next term.

The children in Rooms 2, 3, and 4 and the year 4's that haven't swum this term will all be swimming weeks 2, 3 and 4 of next term.

Check with teachers if you are not sure when your year 4 is swimming.

The children are put on a bus with their teacher (and usually teacher aides) and taken to WaiSplash.

There are WaiSplash instructors who work with groups of children to improve their water skills and swimming ability.

They are then bussed back to school at the end of the session.
