Some urgent notices below - please read...

Athletics:

There is no food available on site this year so children need to bring a good lunch, morning tea, snack and plenty to drink (water).

Any parents or whanau that would like to come along and watch (aka help) are most welcome.



Teacher Strike Action:

Pet Day:

SUNSMART SCHOOL:
