

After nearly 10km of mostly uphill hiking we arrived at Daly's Clearing Hut at 2pm. We set about organising our bunk arrangements for the night. The huts have no power or cooking facilities, so we had carried our propane stoves in our backpacks which we used to cook our dinners and desserts. We played cards, worked on our 'keeping ourselves safe' activities and enjoyed each others company. After a peaceful night in Daly's Clearing Hut, we got up and made our breakfast porridge. Each morning we repack our backpacks to make them as comfortable as possible for the day ahead.
