Dear Parents/Caregivers

STRIKE ACTION - PAPAKOWHAI SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED ON FRIDAY 16TH NOVEMBER.

The NZEI has advised the Papakowhai School Board of Trustees that all teaching staff at our school will be taking strike action for the full day on Friday 16th November.

The Board of Trustees is not able to provide childcare during the strike action. It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike.

Teachers will be rallying at the Te Rauparaha park in Porirua at 12 noon on Friday. Parents and children are welcome to attend the rally if they would like to.

PAPAKOWHAI SCHOOL ZONE

Grandparent Zone Clause

The term **grandparent clause** is a provision in which an old rule continues to apply to some existing situations while a new rule will apply to all future cases. Those exempt from the new rule are said to have grandparent rights or acquired rights, or to have been grandparented in.

It does not apply to children living with their grandparents.

The Papakowhai School BOT and the Ministry of Education have approved the following grandparenting clause. This clause is effective immediately but cannot be added to the official zoning wording until 1 May 2019. It gives certainty of enrolment to siblings of current students in streets that were excluding in the recent zoning change.

The grandparent zone clause only applies to students living in:

Routeburn Street, odd numbers 1 -9 inclusive

- Aotea Drive, odd numbers 1-23 inclusive
- · Sommerset Retirement Village
- Te Puia Drive, odd numbers 1-39 inclusive
- · Tararua Close
- · Tirowhanga Road and its side streets, and Seascape Views.
- · Fiordland Place and Abel Glen.
- · Okowai Road, Frances Brown Ave and its side streets.
- · Queen Charlotte Drive and its side streets.
- Manapouri Lane
- Glenorchy Way
- Kaiteriteri Close
- Baxter's Rise and its side streets.

This clause only applies to new entrant students who were living at the named addresses prior to 1 January 2019 and continue to live at that address until the child starts school.

These students must also have had an older sibling who was enrolled at Papakowhai School prior to the amendment on 1 January 2019, and who is still a current pupil.

These students will be able to enrol as "in zone".

This clause is in effect from 1 January 2019 and covers new entrant children starting school before 31 December 2023.

We have a parent input process where parents/caregivers may submit a feedback form to share concerns or issues

that may impact placement. This information will be kept confidential. The parent input process is not intended to offer the opportunity to request a specific teacher.

Consideration will focus on the student need identified.

To guarantee that your request informs the process we are using, please complete the following Google form https://goo.gl/forms/ECDlvbXHvsa61oT22 no later than Friday 23rd November. If you cannot complete the form online, please contact the office and we will provide you with a paper copy.

Special considerations may be based on the following challenges:

- Social
- Learning
- · Emotional
- Physical
- Past personal history with individuals (students or adults) that may substantially impact your child.

Requests for dealing with these special considerations should take the form of identifying:

- · A teaching strength that may be needed to support your child
- A class level that would better meet your child's needs
- A peer that is requested as a positive support to directly address the special need
- · A past experience that should not be repeated.
