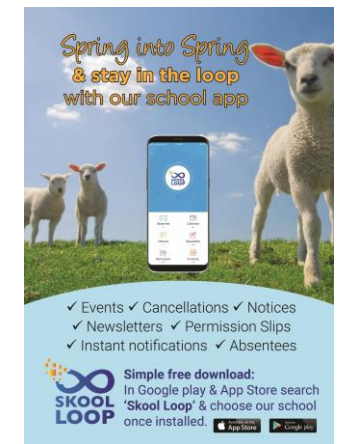
WEEK 6 LEARNING AWARDS
