All students who are swimming will need their own togs and towel.

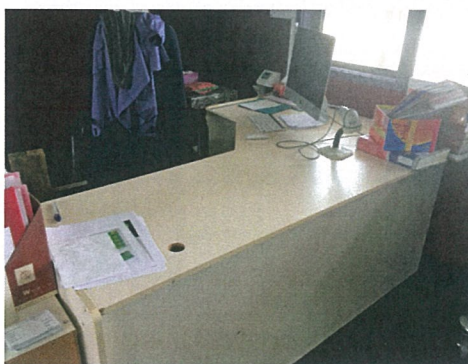
## Year 8 Dinner
