Principal's Comments:

Dear Families and Friends,

A warm welcome back to all our parents and students for 2019 and a

special welcome to our 37 new families who joined us at the beginning of the school year. We also have 10 International Students which is wonderful. Our total roll is 389.

For our new families, I send a newsletter out every fortnight, on the Thursday of even school weeks, which is then followed by an assembly on the Friday at 9.00am. Parents are encouraged to attend these assemblies. Tomorrow, Room 16 will present their class item.

A reminder that children should be at school after 8.30am, no sooner and before 8.50am. These times are important as it allows teachers to finalise their planning and it also assists with social development. I have found that children that consistently arrive late struggle with friendships.

Thank you to all the families that used the Online Shop to buy uniform, a first for us. It has appeared this new way of purchasing has been seamless, which is good. We still sell caps/bucket hats at school. If during the year you need to purchase uniform please log onto our website, www.belmont.school.nz and click on Online Shop.

On Wednesday 27 February we will have our first Parent Teacher Conference. School will close at 12.30pm. Please ensure you make arrangements for the collection of your child. Mrs Bioletti will be sending out the electronic booking forms on Monday.

As our current families know we are endeavoring to reduce waste at school and are asking all lunch waste to go home and think of other ways to wrap food, yet keep it fresh.

Our second initiative from last year was to encourage self regulatory behaviours which include encouraging children to walk, bike or scooter to school.

As you are probably aware the Government has announced a review of the current education system which has been in place for 30 years. The staff are currently reviewing and discussing the 32 recommendations. My personal view is that we need a review. Thirty years is a long time to let educational frameworks pass without a review. I am a strong advocate for equity in education. Every school in New Zealand should have strong leadership, fabulous teachers and should be well resourced. Whichever school a child goes to, they should expect high quality education. The reality is this is not so. The Principal could be inadequate, the staff may not be of quality and the Board may not have spent wisely on property maintenance, upgrades or resources. Two of the recommendations I do not agree with include the use of Hubs, which is a bureaucratic organisation which will sit between schools and the Ministry of Education and support all 125 schools on the North Shore. They will be busy!! Our community is fortunate that we have strong Boards with skilled people and they know our community and we know the children. I do not agree with Principals moving to new schools every five years, which the reviewers think will stop competition and choice.
