#### SCHOOL TRIATHLON

The Papakowhai School triathlon is a fun, have a go event for all children and all abilities. Refreshments and BBQ food will be available for purchase. The registration fee is \$20 per child. If an adult from each family volunteers at the event the fee will be reduced to \$10 per child.

- Year 1 & 2 500m Run, 500m Bike, Swim 45 m (3 lengths of school pool)
- Year 3 & 4 1km Run, 1km Bike, Swim 90m (6 lengths)
- Year 5 + 1.5km Run, 1.5km Bike ,Swim 135m (9 lengths)

Our school pool is shallow and less confident swimmers will be able to stand up if they need to.

been cancelled and we are waiting further advice on the situation.

#### MUSICAL EDUCATION AT WELLINGTON CATHEDRAL

Are you interested in an opportunity for your children to gain a free music education and singing tuition at Wellington Cathedral of St Paul, an acknowledged centre of musical excellence, on Molesworth Street.

There are two junior choirs at the Cathedral: the <u>Children's Choir</u> is for children aged 5-8; members are taught basic musicianship and singing technique in a weekly rehearsal, and join with the Cathedral Choristers for a monthly Thursday evening service.

The <u>Cathedral Choristers</u> are a robed choir of 8-15 year old children, whose skills are developed in singing technique, music theory, public speaking and teamwork through two weekly rehearsals. They lead the weekly Thursday evening Evensong service, with choristers reciting the readings as well as leading all the sung components.
