The Minister of Education (Chris Hipkins), President of NZPF (Whetu Cormack), President of Te Akatea (Myles Ferris) and Chair of the independent taskforce reviewing the Tomorrow's Schools policy (Bali Haque) all spoke regarding their projection of what changes need to be made to the NZ school system. 
