## **Board of Trustee News**

Every 3 years all schools in New Zealand must go through an election process to form a Governing Board. Waikite Valley School Board of Trustees must consist of 5 parent members, 1 staff member and the Principal. At our last election in 2016 we had 8 parents nominated for the board. It is most beneficial for communities to have a selection of representatives to vote on. The Board of Trustees are intended to be an accurate representation of our school community.

Both parents and people from throughout the wider community can be school trustees. It is important that boards represent the diversity of their school communities to ensure a bright future for all our children. The trustee elections give parents the opportunity to vote for candidates who will make a positive difference for all students at their schools. It is an important responsibility, and all eligible parents should use their vote in an informed way.
