School Lawns

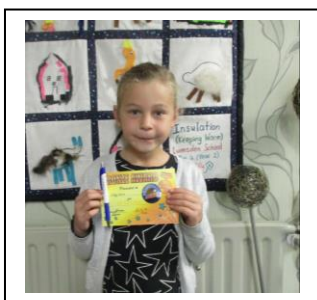
Here are the guidelines to follow;
